Batch Summary averages values more precise (CA-597)

The [Batch Summary](#) average values will now display to the hundredth decimal to provide COMMANDassurance customers with more precise values. Values in the rest of the report will continue to be displayed with the same rounding as before this change.



Batch Summary logic more consistent with CONNEX Insights (CA-603)

The logic for identifying the correct slump reading for each status in the [Batch Summary](#) report has been updated to match the logic in the CONNEX Insights reporting. This will allow both COMMANDassurance and CONNEX Insights reports to be more consistent with each other.



Slump readings retained 20 minutes on equipment rollover (CA-605)

For users of COMMANDassurance, the [Equipment Map](#) can now retain the most recent Slump reading received from the probe for up to 20 minutes. This value can be set to appear on the equipment rollover window to allow dispatcher quick insight into the truck probe status.

Corrections

The following tickets are improvements upon unexpected user experiences for a more fluid and productive experience throughout TrackIt.



Cursor does not default to text box on Time Card

(FEL-3286)

Corrected behavior:

The cursor on the [Time Card](#) page now defaults to the text box when the user is prompted to enter a comment.

Previous behavior:

On the Time Card page, the cursor would not default to the text box when a prompt to enter a comment appeared.



Editing Time Card returns users to incorrect place

(FEL-3373)

Corrected behavior:

Users making edits to the [Time Card](#) page will be returned to their place on the page after their edits are saved.

Previous behavior:

The Time Card page in the TrackIt Web Console returned users to the top of the page after an edit was saved instead of returning users to their previous place on the page.



Incorrect List messages sent from Equipment Map

(CA-608)

Corrected behavior:

List messages sent from the [Equipment Map](#) will now appear on the receivers device as expected and entered by the sender.

Previous behavior:

When users sent List messages from the Equipment Map, the message would display on the tablet with an option that only showed a single apostrophe. The other List message options would display as expected.
