Dispatch view for Employee and Equipment message box blocking rows (TP1-1593)

Corrected behavior:

Corrected a bug on the messages window/panel was blocking the rows of data in the table on Equipment Dispatch and Employee Dispatch.

Dispatch view > Employee Dispatch and Dispatch view > Equipment Dispatch

Previous behavior:

The Dispatch view for the Employee and Equipment message box was blocking rows of data.

Highlight on Engine signal report masking(TP1-1622)'bad ed' on trucks

Corrected behavior:

Corrected a visibility issue on the Engine Signal report hover over highlight. When hovering over rows the highlight would change the legend colors. The highlight has now been adjusted to not impact those colors.

Previous behavior:

Visibility issue occurred on the Engine Signal report hover over highlight.





Left menu navigation bar not static on smaller screens
